Los Angeles: Just a quick stop with the option to rest after the travel or a day trip to Disneyland

Tahoe / Reno Nevada: This beautiful mountain lake area is where the great TV show Bonanza was filmed. Spectacular scenery! Reno also has the second largest amount of casinos, so lots of show to choose from, or go dancing to one of the local bands.

Virginia City: A day trip to Virginia City. This is a little town which has survived progress. It is still very much like it was in the days of the cowboys. Memphis Tennessee: Graceland - tour the home and museum of the King of Rock 'n' Roll Elvis Presley. At nighttime we'll head down to Beale Street. Memphis Blues comes alive. See where Elvis, BB King, Chuck Berry, Carl Perkins, and many more all got their influence.

Branson Missouri: Over 100 theatres with shows on three times a day. Two evening shows will be included in the package leaving you plenty of time to catch other shows too. Big star names plus lots of entertaining smaller shows.

Route 66: Just a short drive from Branson is Springfield where we hit the historic and world famous Route 66. We'll stop at one of the Rock 'n' Roll 50s theme cafes for lunch on route to St Louis. Later, experience the R&R dancing for yourself!

Pigeon Forge: Visiting Dollywood and the Dixie Stampedo. Dinner is included. Two days here gives you plenty of time to visit the huge outlet malls to do some shopping.
